<p>Homogenisation</p>	<p><b>Universalism:</b> To reduce the singularities to what the manifold has in common – NEOLIBERAL EUROPEANISATION (Modernism: Liberalism/ Imperialism): the Net is imposed upon the Selves</p>	<p><b>Unity without Diversity</b></p>

Homogenisation	<b>Universalism</b>	<b>Unity without Diversity</b>
	<b>Particularism:</b> To project one singularity onto an imaginary common – REACTIVE PSEUDO- EUROPEANISATION (Antimodernism: Fundamentalism/ Totalitarianism): one Self establishes itself as the Net

## European Union

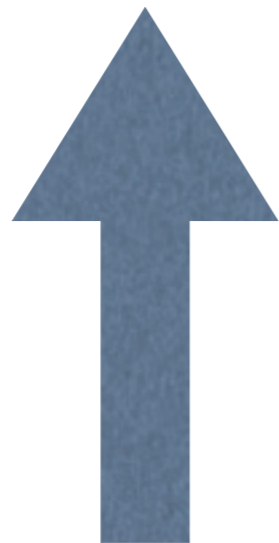
### AUFHEBUNG/SUBLATION (Hegel)

1. Abolition: The new discontinues history. The European Union differs qualitatively from the old agglomeration of nation states.
2. Conservation: The One depends on the Many. The European Union depends on the variety of its constituents.
3. Lifting onto a higher level: The Many undergo a transformation. The partitions of the European Union cohere to maintain the European Union.
